Criteria for all Indigenous applicants:

- Must be attending a post secondary institution, in first year or above (ie. not in high school)
- Undergraduate students may receive this award only once every two years, even if in graduating year. They may not be on internship at the time of the application. They may receive the scholarship twice during their undergraduate degree.
- Graduate students may receive this award only once for each post graduate degree.

Submission requirements:

Student must submit a letter with application, describing:

- Why you deserve this award
- Your education to date, awards, community services, participation in sports, music or the arts, career aspirations
- A paragraph describing why you would like to work in the mining industry
- Unofficial transcript
- If you win, would you attend dinner at 7 p.m on Mar.19th Sheraton Cavalier, or send photo?

Student marks are not the main measure for the scholarship selection, but we require you to submit transcripts (unofficial is acceptable) showing your marks for the previous academic year or past term.

This application, and copy of your letter and transcript of marks, must be received by CIM Saskatoon Executives no later than Thursday February 6th, 2020. The application is to be e-mailed to the Branch at CIMSKScholarships@cim.org with the subject line, "Attention Scholarship Committee".

You will be emailed a confirmation-of-receipt of your application. It is your responsibility to follow-up with the CIM Saskatoon Branch, by February 7th at noon, if you did not receive a confirmation by email. After February 7th at noon, entry to the scholarship evaluation process is closed. If your application was not received and you did not follow-up by noon on February 7th, we encourage you to apply in future years.

Declaration by applicant and parent:

I understand and agree that:

- Applicants who did not receive an email from the CIM Saskatoon Branch to confirm that the application was received are not eligible for the 2019-2020 scholarship.
- The CIM Saskatoon Branch Scholarship Selection Committee decisions are final and binding.
- The applicant must at a minimum send a photo by Mar. 18th that can be used at the meeting to recognize they received the scholarship.
- The names and photos of successful applicants may be used in on-line and other communications of CIM and post-secondary institutions, and all communications will be considered the property of the CIM Saskatoon Branch.
- The applicant is an adult who is of age of majority to sign this contract.
- Recipients of the award are to provide their social insurance number for income tax purposes.
