

# SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM

## SUMMARY OF OPPORTUNITIES

As a result of public health guidelines related to COVID-19 the CIM Saskatoon Branch pivoted to deliver technical events as webinars rather than traditional technical in person dinners. Webinar attendance has ranged from 40 to 150 people, which is we consider a success. We will continue to host webinars to facilitate the exchange of information as long as long as restrictions on physical gatherings remain in place. Our goal is a return to our traditional technical event dinners as soon as permitted by Provincial guidelines. With vaccinations underway, the package outlines sponsor benefits assuming a return to in person events.

The CIM Saskatoon Branch is seeking scholarship and technical event sponsors for 2021-2022. Scholarship sponsorship supports a scholarship program for post-secondary students, while technical event sponsorship subsidizes the costs of hosting monthly technical events to maintain affordability, encourage participation, and provide discounted ticket prices to student participants. Traditionally, monthly events include networking opportunities, dinner, and an industry speaker presenting on topics according to the following events schedule:

During each technical event, the logos of all scholarship and technical event sponsors are shown on table cards, in a PowerPoint presentation, and are recognized during opening remarks. Some sponsor levels also include online recognition and promotion along with events in social media.

Scholarships are awarded to post-secondary students who have an interest in mining and who participate in CIM events. Additionally, a scholarship was created for indigenous applicants to promote the awareness of, and involvement in, the local mining community and industry at large. Since 2007, CIM Saskatoon Branch has awarded a more than \$317,000 to more than 180 students studying at the University of Saskatchewan and Saskatchewan Polytechnic in mining related programs. Support has also been provided to undergraduate competitions like the World Mining Competition and Canadian Mining Games. Post-secondary students are actively encouraged to attend events to network with industry members and hopefully to inspire them to seek permanent employment in the mining industry. A component of the scholarship eligibility is for students to attend at least three CIM Saskatoon Branch events between September and February.

Benefits from student engagement and scholarship programs is being realized locally as demographics of monthly technical events are broadening with participants ranging from students through to retirees. Furthermore, these students have been engaging more with the mining community by volunteering in mining related outreach events with the public, and the CIM Saskatoon Branch.
