**Criteria for All Student Members:**

- There will be a tier system for awarding scholarships with higher values given based on the evaluations of extracurricular activities and/or the professionalism/content of the letter
- Must be attending a post-secondary institution, in first year or above (ie. not in high school) and must be enrolled at the time of awarding of scholarship
- Must have attended at least **three CIM Saskatoon Branch** events during the 2021-2022 CIM term between February 2021 and January 2022, if in-person events are held. Higher attendance and extracurricular involvement given preference. If dinners are cancelled, attendance at other events will be given higher priority
- Undergraduate students may receive this award only once every two academic years, including graduating year
- Cannot be on internship from January 2022 to April 2022. They may receive the scholarship twice during their undergraduate degree
- Graduate students may receive this award only once for each post-graduate degree
- All student applicants must be current CIM National Student members (<https://cim.org/membership/student-member/>) and CIM Saskatoon Branch members (join at <https://store.cim.org/en/saskatoon-branch> )
- Even in meeting the criteria above, a scholarship is not guaranteed

You will be emailed a confirmation-of-receipt of your application. It is your responsibility to follow-up with CIM Saskatoon Branch by February 4<sup>th</sup> at noon if you did not receive the confirmation email. After February 4<sup>th</sup> at noon, entry to the scholarship evaluation process is closed. If your application was not received and you did not follow-up by noon on February 4<sup>th</sup>, we encourage you to apply in future years.
