Criteria for All Student Members:

- There will be a tier system for awarding scholarships with higher values given based on the evaluations of extracurricular activities and/or the professionalism/content of the letter
- Must be attending a post-secondary institution, in **second year or above** and must be enrolled at the time of awarding of scholarship
- Must have attended at least **three CIM Saskatoon Branch** events between February 2025 and January 2026, if in-person events are held. Higher attendance and extracurricular involvement given preference. If dinners are cancelled, attendance at other events may be considered
- Undergraduate students (university or diploma post-secondary programs) may receive this award only once every two academic years, including graduating year
- Cannot be at a coop/internship job from January 2026 to April 2026. They may receive the scholarship twice during their regular undergraduate program
- Graduate students may receive this award only once for each post-graduate degree
- All student applicants must be current CIM National Student members (https://cim.org/membership/student-member). We verify with National that memberships are current
- Meeting the above criteria does not guarantee a scholarship
- Incomplete applications will not be considered

You will be emailed a confirmation-of-receipt of your application. It is your responsibility to follow-up with CIM Saskatoon Branch by February 6 at noon if you did not receive the confirmation email. After February 6 at noon, entry to the scholarship evaluation process is closed. If your application was not received and you did not follow-up by noon on February 6, we encourage you to apply in future years.
